Course: **HS 103 (ICS 300) Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents**
Course Length: **20 hours** from 0800-1700 hrs.

Course Description:

This **2 Day** course combines an overview of the basic concepts presented in I-200 and expanded upon to include learning objectives of the I-300 Unified Command System. The unified command organization and structure are stressed. Students are exposed to the Planning “P”, Incident objectives, ICS forms and their functions, resource management, demobilization, transfer of command and Incident closeout. Through a series of small group exercises, students will be provided examples of how the essential system principles and components are used in incident planning.
