## **Denver UASI and North Central Region Training Announcement**

The UASI/NCR Training Committee is pleased to announce the following courses.

**Course:**                   **HS 104 (ICS 400) Advanced ICS Command and General Staff-Complex Incidents**

**Course Length:**       **16 hours** from 0800-1700 hrs.

### **Course Description:**

This course is intended for senior personnel who are expected to perform in a management capacity in an Area Command or multiagency coordination system. The course is designed to provide overall incident management skills rather than tactical expertise. Course goals are: to explain how major incidents have special management challenges; introduce Major and/or Complex Incident/Event Management, describe the circumstances in which an Area Command is established; describe the circumstances in which multiagency coordination systems are established. Topics will also include unified command, area command and multi-agency coordination. A series of exercises build on the basic principals learned in ICS-100/200 and 300 culminating in a final exercise.
